**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-18**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH FUND 2256 OPIOID SETTLEMENT  
UNRESTRICTED FUND AND FUND 2257 OPIOID SETTLEMENT  
RESTRICTED FUND PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 36-1-3**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-1-3-4 provides a municipality all powers necessary to conduct its affairs, even if not expressly granted by statute;

WHEREAS, the Town of Dayton, Indiana (hereinafter the “Town”) opted into the Indiana Opioid Settlement and has received or will receive funds from the settlement to combat opioid addiction in the community;

WHEREAS, the Town has determined it is necessary to establish a fund, 2256 Opioid Settlement Unrestricted Fund and 2257 Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund which shall be funded by said settlement proceeds; and


WHEREAS, such funds shall continue in existence until such time as all the monies within the funds are exhausted, and after their exhaustion, shall be terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAYTON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is hereby established fund 2256 Opioid Settlement Unrestricted Fund and 2257 Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund to receive funds from the opioid settlement for the purpose of combatting opioid addiction in the community.

2. The funds shall continue in existence until such time as all the funds are exhausted, and after their exhaustion, shall be terminated.

3. No part of this Ordinance shall be interpreted to conflict with any local, state, or federal laws, and all reasonable efforts should be made to harmonize the same. Should any section




or part of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than that portion so declared to be invalid, and for this purpose, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

4. This Ordinance shall be in effect upon its adoption.
