AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 75.99: PARKING REGULATIONS PENALTY

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-1-3-4 provides a municipality all powers necessary to conduct its affairs, even if not expressly granted by statute;

WHEREAS, the Town of Dayton, Indiana, (hereinafter the “Town”) adopted Chapter 75.99: Penalty in the Town’s Parking Regulations in Ordinance No. 73-5 in 1973, and such Chapter was amended in Ordinance No. 01-06 on September 10, 2001, and amended again in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the best interest of the Town to amend Chapter 75.99 to revise the penalty for commercial vehicles which violate the Town’s Parking Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAYTON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

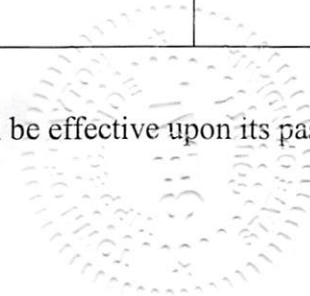
1. The Town of Dayton, Indiana, Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by amending and restating Chapter 75.99 as follows:

§ 75.99 PENALTY

Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provision of Chapter 75 of this title for which another penalty is not otherwise specifically provided shall, upon conviction or judgment being entered, be subject to a fine pursuant to the schedule below:

Type of Vehicle	First Offense	Second Offense	Third Offense	Fourth and Subsequent Offenses Occurring within Six (6) Months
Non-commercial vehicles	\$25.00	\$50.00	\$75.00	\$100.00
Commercial Vehicles (includes all vehicles for which a CDL is required, excepting school busses)	\$100.00	\$150.00	\$200.00	\$250.00

2. This amendatory ordinance shall be effective upon its passage after publication and posting as required by Indiana law.

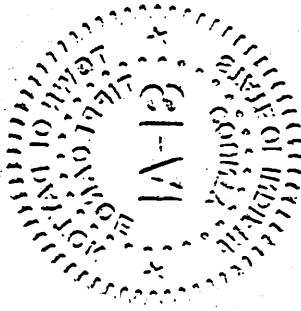
